#### Zip Patch Approximate Burst Strength

#### **PVC and Steel Pipe Repairs**

**Sample A:** Control sample done of 7/8 in (22 mm) PVC pipe (Schedule 80). No holes. Pipe pressurised with cap on opposite end. Burst measured at 2596 psi (179 bar).

**Sample B:** A 7/8 in (22 mm) PVC pipe drilled with two 1/8 in (3 mm) holes in opposing locations. Pipe was wrapped with impregnated fibreglass 1-1/2 times prociding a single layer over one hole and a double layer over the second hole. Burst measured at 2494 psi (172 bar).

**Sample 3:** A 7/8 in (22 mm) PVC pipe cut with hacksaw blade to make 7/8 in (22 mm) opening. Patched with double wrap of impregnated fibreglass. Burst measured at 1400 psi (96.5 bar).

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
